

G2 Ops Wins PMW 770 Engineering Support Services Contract

Virginia Beach, VA, USA (22 July 2025) – The U.S. Navy Undersea Communications and Integration Program Office (PMW 770) has awarded G2 Ops a five-year contract valued at \$111 million to provide systems engineering, security engineering, and Model-Based Systems Engineering (MBSE) services.
