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RMF Step 5: Authorize System

- Develop complete authorization package
 - Conduct risk analysis and POA&M development
 - Coordinate with AO/ISSM for authorization decision

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RMF Step 6: Continuous Monitoring (Preparation for Sustainment)

- Develop Continuous Monitoring Strategy
- Define processes for ongoing assessments and reporting
- Prepare system for post-ATO operations and compliance
